Bristol Development Group's Velocity showcased as model project

Velocity, a \$60 million mix-used development under construction in The Gulch, will be showcased as a model project at the 46th International Making Cities Livable Conference in Santa Fe, N.M., June 1-5, 2008.

The IMCL conference has been a bi-annual event in the United States and Europe for over 20 years. The event is a platform for city officials, architects, planners, developers, community leaders, behavioral scientists, artists, and others responsible for the livability of their cities to exchange experiences, ideas and expertise.

Velocity was selected on the basis of vitality, scale, utility and attention to community life.

The project is being development by two Nashville-based companies -- Bristol Development Group and **Marketstreet Enterprises**.

The architect and design team is ka, a Cleveland Ohio-based firm.
