District 18 goes Green

A neighborhood meeting will be held at 7 p.m. Oct. 8 at Belmont United Methodist Church to kick-off a new Go Green campaign in District 18.

Mayor Karl Dean will discuss his "Making Nashville Green" initiatives at the meeting.

Go Green, District 18 is an initiative to reduce District 18's energy consumption by five percent. Homeowners and businesses in District 18 are encouraged to sign up for an NES In-Home Energy Evaluation to help decrease their power usage.

District 18's boundaries are Interstate 440, 12th Avenue South, Blakemore Avenue, 21st Avenue South and West End Avenue.

This initiative is supported by NES and TVA, the Urban Land Institute, and Village Real Estate Services, according to materials distributed announcing the meeting.
